

## Conference Structure

*“Choose this day whom you will serve...  
but as for me and my house,  
we will serve the Lord!” Joshua 24:15*

The vision for Men’s Ministry in the Anglican Diocese of South Carolina and the Christian Men’s Conference is “to equip today’s men to be tomorrow’s disciple makers,” with the outcome being spiritually healthy men leading as disciple makers in their homes, communities, and churches,

We use the word “home” over family, and include church and community, because regardless of whether you are married or single, all men have a place they call home, we all have community, and “we are the church. These are the places for disciple making.

The outcome of this commitment to discipleship in the “home” we believe is presented in such a powerful way in Joshua 24:15 and John 4:53. Both verses speak directly to the important spiritual role men have in the life of their homes.

## TALK 2: REFLECTION QUESTIONS

Take 5 minutes of silence. No talking. No phones. Just you and God. Ask the Holy Spirit: "Where am I on this journey? What do You want me to see about myself?"

### ADAM (אָדָם) - THE CREATIONAL MALE

Who are you trying to be self-sufficient from? (God? Your wife? Other men? Your church? Where have you bought the "self-made man" lie?)

Where do you get your sense of worth? (Your job title? Your bank account? Your accomplishments? What would it feel like to lose that thing?)

Do you really believe you're capable of horrific evil? (Not just "little sins"—horrific evil. Until you embrace this, do you really understand what Jesus saved you FROM?)

### ZAKAR (זָכָר) - THE SEXUAL MALE

Have you embraced your sexual nature as God-given? (Or are you ashamed of it? Or have you made it ultimate? It's neither something to worship nor something to hide.)

Do you control your sexual behavior, or does it control you? (Can you feel attraction without pursuing it? Or do you HAVE to act on every impulse?)

Do you have REAL accountability? (Not “How you doing?” once a month. Real accountability—men who know your struggles, have access to your devices, ask hard questions.)

### GIBBOR (גיבור) - THE WARRIOR MALE

Are you fighting right now? Or have you given up? (If you're in your 20s-30s, this is your GIBBOR stage. Are you building, establishing, proving yourself? Or have you quit?)

Are you trusting your strength or God's? (David said, “The battle is the LORD's.” Do you believe that? Or do you believe the battle is yours and God is just your assistant?)

Do you know when to quit? (Not every battle is worth fighting. What battle are you fighting right now that you need to let go?)

Write down what comes to mind. Don't edit it. Just write it.

Then we'll go to Small Groups.

And when we come back, we'll talk about what happens when the warrior gets wounded - when life breaks you and you enter ENOSH.

But for now: Be honest with yourself. Be honest with God. You are ADAM. You are ZAKAR. You are GIBBOR.

The question is: What will you do with that reality?





### TALK 3: REFLECTION QUESTIONS

Take 5 minutes of silence. No talking. No phones. Just you and God.

Ask the Holy Spirit: "Where am I on this journey? What do You want me to see about myself?"

#### ENOSH (אֲנוֹשׁ) – THE WOUNDED MALE

What is your wound? (What loss have you experienced that you've never fully grieved? What broke you that you've never admitted broke you?)

Have you grieved it, or have you covered it? (Did you express the pain honestly? Or did you medicate it, deny it, let it leak out as anger?)

Are you limping toward God or away from God? (Are you wrestling with Him like Job and Jacob? Or are you ghosting Him?)

#### ISH (אִישׁ) – THE MATURE MALE

Do you know who you actually are? (Or are you still being who others want you to be — Dad, boss, wife, church, culture?)

Are your relationships codependent or mature? (Can you be connected without losing yourself? Can you be intimate without being engulfed?)

Are you ruling your life through Scripture or through culture? (Have you outsourced your theology? Or do you actually know what you believe and why?)

### ZAKEN (זָקֵן) – THE SAGE MALE

What are you building toward — retirement and leisure, or wisdom and contribution? (Are you preparing to fade away? Or preparing to finish well?)

Who are you mentoring? (What younger man is watching your life and learning how to be a man?)

How do you want to die? (Bitter and disconnected? Or full of years, at peace, with relationships reconciled?)

Write down what comes to mind. Don't edit it. Just write it.

Then we'll move forward.

And tonight, we'll talk about how to actually WALK this journey with other men.

We'll end with a time of surrender — surrendering what needs surrendering and receiving what God wants to give.

But for now: Be honest with yourself. Be honest with God.

You are ADAM. You are ZAKAR. You are GIBBOR.

You will be ENOSH. You can become ISH. You're heading toward ZAKEN.

The question is: What will you do with that reality?





## TALK 4: REFLECTION QUESTIONS

Take 5 minutes of silence. No talking. No phones. Just you and God. Ask the Holy Spirit: "What do I need to surrender tonight?"

### IDENTIFYING YOUR FALSE-SELF:

Which false-self pattern am I stuck in? (Pride/Perfectionism from humiliation? Pleasure/Addiction from rejection? Self-Absorption/Materialism from abandonment?)

What fortress did I build to protect myself? (What vow did I make after being wounded? "I'll never let myself be vulnerable again..." What did YOU vow?)

What am I trying to control that I need to let go of? (The outcome? My image? Other people's opinions? My comfort? My security?)

### THE SIX COMPONENTS:

**AWARENESS:** What's not working? (Where is my way creating problems instead of solving them? Where am I stuck?)

**CHOICE:** Am I willing to move from fear to love? (Fear says "protect yourself." Love says "trust God." Which voice am I feeding?)

**SILENCE:** When was the last time I sat in complete silence and listened for God's voice? (Is the noise in my head too loud to hear Him say "I love you, you are enough, you can let go"?)

**GRATITUDE:** What am I grateful for right now? (Can I name three things? Can I be grateful and angry at the same time?)

**ATTITUDE:** What attitude am I choosing? (Am I choosing trust or bitterness? Hope or cynicism? Freedom or resentment?)

**ACTION:** What do I need to actually let go of tonight? (Not just think about letting go. Actually let go. What is it?)

### **WHAT I'M SURRENDERING TONIGHT:**

If stuck in **PRIDE/PERFECTIONISM** (ADAM wound): Am I surrendering the need to have it all together? The need to be right? The need to control everything?

If stuck in **PLEASURE/ADDICTION** (ZAKAR wound): Am I surrendering the pornography? The affair? The substance? The codependent relationship?

If stuck in SELF-ABSORPTION/MATERIALISM (GIBBOR wound): Am I surrendering the belief that I have to do it alone? The materialism? The walls I've built?

### WHAT I'M RECEIVING:

What is God offering me in exchange for my false-self? (His peace instead of control? His love instead of performance? His presence instead of isolation?)

Can I receive it? (Not earn it. Not prove I deserve it. Just receive it.)


What would my life look like if I actually surrendered this tonight? (How would I be different tomorrow? Next week? Next year?)

Write down what comes to mind. Don't edit it. Just write it. This is between you and God.

Tonight is about surrender. Not thinking about surrender.  
Not understanding surrender. Actually surrendering.  
Opening your hands. Giving it back over to God.  
Receiving your true-self in Him.

Returning to the image you were made to bear.




